 KIND BOUGHT BY CFD, FIRST SEAGRAVE OF THIS TYPE ASSIGNED
 TO TRUCK 11, AND THEN TO TRUCK 20, IN 1920. ORIGINAL TRUCK
 ABOVE ASSIGNED TO TRUCK 17 UNTIL TRUCK 38 GOT IT IN 1925.

ENGINE 19 - house as it stood at 3444
 Rhodes Avenue just before it was given
 up by the city to fall under weckers
 hammer in 1953. This was originally
 a three story building when it was
 built in 1892. On April 22, 1927, -
 officers and members traded houses with
 Engine 21 at 14 W. Taylor Street and
 became the second Negro company in CHGO.
 On December 7, 1953, Engine 19 moved to
 Engine 48, where they remained until X
 April 16, 1956, when they moved to new
 and decorative quarters with Truck 11,
 and Ambulance 4, at 3419 Calumet Avenue.
