- Checking special hydrant wrenches for operation as well as thread adapters
- Checking VHF fireground radio frequencies between City and suburban companies

- Topics for discussion operational procedures, special areas worthy of note, equipment orientations
- Radio frequency interoperability IFERN, fireground
- Chief officers post-discussion topics
